

1. Commune Development Plan and Investment Program (CDP/CIP)

The Cambodia has fully been undertaking a Democratic Development through Decentralization and Decentration Programme from 2002. This reform program is carried out by following approaches:

- Law on The Administration and Management of Commune/Sangkat was developed and promulgated by the Royal Kram
- Commune/Sangkat Council is established by the democratic election, two elections have been completed, first election was organized in 2002 and second was organized in 2007,
- Commune/Sangkat Democratic Development through Decentralization and Deconcentration Programme has been embarked from 2002 onward
- Technical Guideline for Commune/Sangkat Development Plan and Investment Program developed and promulgated by Inter-ministerial circular or PRAKA.

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


- Having seen the Constitution of the Kingdom of Cambodia;

- Having seen Royal Kram No. 02/94 dated 20 July 1994, promulgating the Law on the Organization and Functioning of the Council of Minister;
- Having seen Royal Kram No. 0196/08 dated 24 January 1996, promulgating the Law on the Establishment of the Ministry of Interior;
- · As per proposals of the Samdech Prime Minister and Co-Ministers of Interior


HEREBY PROMULGATE

The Law on the Administration and Management of Commune/Sangkat that was passed by the National Assembly on 12 January 2001 during the fifth session of its second legislature and approved by the Senate on its form and legal concepts on 0.1 February during the fourth session of its first legislature and was declared as constitutional by the Constitutional Council by decision No. 0.41/003/2001 dated 28 February 2001, the entire content of which is as follows:









1. Capital and Province Development Plan and Investment Program (C/PDP and C/PIP)

Learning from reform program at Commune/Sangkat, Royal Government of Cambodia is scaling-up this program to capital and provincial levels. In order to facilitate this process, some crucial tools and protocol documents developed are:

- Law for Administrative Management at Capital, Provincial, Municipalities, District and Khan developed and promulgated by Royal Kram since 2008
- Capital, Provincial, Municipality, District and Khan Council established by democratic election in 2009
- National Program for Democratic Development at Sub-national level developed and lunched by the Royal Government of Cambodia, 10 year program 2009-2019
- Technical Guideline for Preparation of Development Plan at Capital, Provincial, Municipalities, District and Khan developed and promulgated by Inter-Ministerial PraKas

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




The Law on Elections of Capital Council, Provincial Council, Municipal Council, District Council and Khan Council which was enacted by the National Assembly on 02 April 2008 at its seventh plenary session of the third legislature and approved entirely without change by the Senate on its form and legal concepts on 29 April 2008 at its fourth plenary session of second legislature and was reviewed and declared constitutional by the Constitutional Council under decision No. 097/002/2008 KBTH.CH (#URS) dated 12 May 2008 with full provisions as follows:











2. What have been doing in Cambodia for promoting integration/Mainstreaming

- Efforts made by NCDM to work with its Development Partners, who are working focusing on disaster risk reduction and climate change adaption, particularly at sub-national and local levels to build capacity of local authorities and other stakeholders and to fine opportunity for integration of DRR and CCA in Sub-national Development planning process.

 Also, NCDM is working with Ministry of Planning to promote integration of DRR and CCA, by involving Ministry of Planning in important events like training activities, exchange of experience workshops, and orientation sessions at subnational and local levels



Capacity Building NDMOs and Stakeholders

- Component 4 of MRC's FMMP supports NCDM to promote integration/mainstreaming flood preparedness program through providing capacity building to local authorities at provincial, district and commune levels,
- Building capacity of stakeholders who are playing led role in supporting local authorities in developing local development plan,
- Supporting NCDM to organize exchange of experience and lesson learnt workshops and consultative workshops.



Dialogues and Consultations



- Series of consultation with partners and other stakeholders to learn and exchange experience of integration






Development of Guideline/Policy Documents for Integration/Mainstreaming

- Supporting NCDM and Ministry of Interior to develop an Guideline for Integration of DRR into Sub-national Development Planning Process
- Supporting NCDM to facilitate with relevant stakeholders and organize consultative workshops for developing integration guideline (26 November, 2010)



3. Achievements

- Disaster risk reduction priority activities and/or projects are emerging in Provincial and Commune Investment Program and prioritized as the top priority activities. However, it is not widely consisted
- Disaster Risk Reduction/Disaster Management has became a one component of Sub-national Development Framework, which included in Technical Guideline for Capital, Provincial, Municipality and District Development Plan and Investment Program



3. Experiences and Way Forward

- Participations and involvements of Disaster Management Committees in all processes of development planning at all levels, will be crucial factors to promote integration DRR into development plan
- Building capacities to planners, managers, and other stakeholders in disaster risk reduction
- Promotion of multi-sector plans would be an ideal approach to promote DRR in each sector
