Issues identified by students for School Safety : Component 1

Structural measures

- Strong school building
- Safe location of the school building
- Response equipments at school

Non-structural measures

- Interesting reading materials
- Responses aspects to be covered in plan
- School safety to be linked with livelihood
- Capacity building of teachers and parents

Issues identified by students for School Safety: Component 1

Other issues

- Up-scaling activities to cover whole country
- How to make the parents listen to children
- School safety plan to have mitigation measures
- Climate change aspects should be covered

Opportunities

- Powerful tools for behavioral change
- DRR initiative helped in bringing confidence

Key School Safety Initiatives : Thailand

- Government led
- Awareness generation is extensive
- School plan
- Students involvement
- Partnership and network

Key School Safety Initiatives : Myanmar

- Focus awareness
- Structural measures
- Linked with other development activities
- Strong institutional mechanism
- Cover Out-of-the school Children

Recommendations

- Child led/centered DRR requires deliberations for linking at national & regional level
- School Safety needs to be linked with other sectors
- Standardization of IEC on School Safety at regional and national levels
- Regional Education Task Force can take up standardization of IEC
- Multi-hazard approach in School Safety needs to be promoted
- Experience sharing on School Safety among Mekong Basin countries to be promoted
- A number of good School Safety Models exist and there is a need of resources for up-scaling
