








- Conducting public awareness campaigns Booklets, posters, "Living with Floods" video






Achievements at the Regional level

Achievements of C4P2: Phase I (2003-2004)















- Development of a Training Course Curriculum on "Implementation of Flood Preparedness Programs at Provincial and District Levels".
- Two National Training Courses conducted on "Implementation of Flood Preparedness Programs" in Cambodia (Kratie, Kampong Cham, Kandal and Prey Veng) and Vietnam (Long An and Dong Thap).
- Two National Seminar organised in Thailand and Lao PDR on "Flood Preparedness Planning".

Achievements C4P3 of Phase II (2005-2006)

- Training Course Curriculum on "Planning and Implementation of Flood Preparedness Programs" in the three riparian country languages (Khmer, Vietnamese and Lao)
- Five Provincial level Training Courses with participation of 168 key officials from provincial and district disaster management committees in Kratie and Kampong Cham Provinces in Cambodia, Can Tho and Tien Giang Provinces in Vietnam and Champasack, Khammoune, Saravanh and Savannakhet provinces of Lao PDR trained on developing and implementation of flood preparedness programs.
- Identification of Priority Action Areas: Training course participants from Kratie and Kampong Cham provinces (Cambodia), Tien Giang provinces (Vietnam) and representatives of the four target province of Champasack, Khammoune, Saravanh, Savannakhet (Lao PDR) prepared list of priority actions areas for implementation of flood preparedness program in their respective provinces.



Phase III Activities (2007-2008)

- Activity 1: Provincial Training Course in Khammouane Province in Lao PDR Publish Training Manual on Flood Preparedness in Lao PDR
- Activity 2: Facilitate Preparation of Flood Preparedness Program and Implementation of Priority Action Areas in the selected districts of the target provinces of Cambodia, Lao PDR and Vietnam.
- Conduct training on "Flood Preparedness for the Commune Disaster Management Committees / Teams" in the 2 target provinces in Vietnam and Cambodia.
