A. Activity Summary

Within the month, more preparation works for the project implementation were carried out. Input of data of the household questionnaire for the baseline survey was complete and results analyzed. Preliminary ward urban planning survey for the two remaining wards was accomplished. Also logistic preparation for the Introductory Workshop was done including room arrangement, approval of the People's Committee for the material and implementation of the workshop and sending of invitation letter. Held on the 15th of June as planned, the workshop was implemented successfully with the presence of Ms Gabrielle Iglesias from ADPC and all stakeholders from the city, district as well as the six wards of Cam Le district. Overall Promise programme and objectives were presented, results of PVA and focused group discussion, household survey and preliminary ward urban planning survey shared and discussed among stakeholders.
