Data Collection for Monsoon 2006 Rains

- The Assessment report for the recent heavy rains is being prepared. The data of low-laying area has been collected; the photographs and the movie of the most rain-hit areas have been taken.
- Close liaison with Irrigation department has been kept for updates on Floods in river Indus, which was in High Floods in the third week of August 2006. The peak flood has passed Hyderabad city safely
