





Monthly Progress Report (September 2006) for the Program for Hydro-Meteorological Risk Mitigation in Secondary cities in Asia (PROMISE) Hyderabad

The monthly summary report for September 2006 is as under

Component 1: Hazard Mapping and Vulnerability Study

Data Collection for Monsoon 2006 Rains

- Huge downpour continued in the month of September 2006 in Hyderabad city with the major reading of 130 millimeter inundating most of the low lying areas in target area. Four people died due to electrocution
- The assessment report for the recent heavy rains is being compiled and finalized. Whereas the photographs and the movie of the most rain-hit areas have been taken.

Hazard Mapping and Vulnerability Study

- Hazard mapping and vulnerability study continued in the month of September although it
 could not be finished and going little longer due to torrential rains in the project area
 inundating entire localities submerged under water for almost two weeks
- Following tools used/are being used for the study:
 - Hazard Mapping
 - Historical Profiling and
 - Seasonal Calendar
 - Transect Walk
 - Interviews with Local Government Officials
 - Livelihood Analysis
 - Venn Diagram
 - Problem Tree

The data collection process for Hazard Mapping and Vulnerability Assessment is almost complete however compilation and analysis of the data will be completed by mid October 2006.

Development of GIS Database

- AKPBS after GIS training has constituted a team for development of GIS database of project areas
- Staff comprising Mr Mehrunnisa Hashmani and Mr Usama Anwer after participation in GIS training conducted field visit and collected coordinates at various points using GPS in the project areas Latifabad, Hyderabad
