A. Activity Summary

In July 2007 the project team: i) finalized poster on construction principles resistant to typhoon and floods ii) continued with development of a set of guidelines on safer construction techniques resistant to typhoons and floods iii) reviewed Disaster Preparedness Plans of the section clusters and ward level iv) collected information on the city emergency rescue system v) completed the two remaining CBDRM training classes at ward level vi) carried out field check for the proposed sub project with ward authority and district representatives vii) attended the Project Coordinators meeting of Promise in Bangkok on 31 July - 1 August 07.

Activities and performance:

 Activity 1.3 Documentation of best practices for community-based smallscale mitigation projects to reduce vulnerability: development of poster on house construction principles.

The poster was approved by the city authority and printed in 100 copies. The poster will be distributed to the communities in the coming month.

Activity 2.5 Risked based urban land use planning training
Activity 2.5.2 Develop guidelines on safe construction techniques

This month the guidelines draft was being reviewed and translated into Vietnamese. Finalization of the guidelines are expected next month The guidelines were developed in collaboration with the Construction department of Danang city and the Construction Consulting Company of Architect Union. The guidelines would be disseminated in the community.

Activity 2.3.1: CBDRM training at community level

+ Review of Disaster Preparedness Plan (DPP) of the section cluster and summarization of subprojects proposed by section clusters

Five DPPs of the section cluster were submitted and are being reviewed by the project team. A sheet of proposed subproject summary was being done to serve as a basic for development of DPP and proposed subprojects at ward level.

+ CBDRM training at ward level:

The remaining two three-day CBDRM training classes at ward level was conducted in Hoa Thoa Dong and Hoa Xuan ward, one from 19th to 21th July, the other from 27th to 29th July 2007 respectively. Totally nearly sixty persons including members of the ward CSFC and representative of the most vulnerable sections (head of sections) attended the training.
