# Component 1

#### **EWS Establishment**

 A Meeting was held at Irrigation office, Kalutara for obtaining the GPS locations of selected flood affected areas in Kalutara.

## I. Neighborhood network to support EOCs

Establishment of EOC and introduced the standard of procedure is one of the major activity of the PROMISE project .The project team has understood the effectiveness of the strengthen the existing EOC of Kalutara rather than functioning a separate EOC in a same city. To avoid the overlapping of the same task, it is important to uplift the capacities of the existing EOC which is functioning as a branch of Government DMC.This EOC also in an initial stage and should develop human and physical resources while developing the SOP,s.

A cluster meeting was held in SCDMC, Moratuwa to discuss the future activities of EOC development of Kalutara on November 8, 2007.

The aims and objectives of the discussion was explained by Ms Priyanka Mudalige and the present status of the existing EOC is explained by Captain Sanjeewa Samaranayake.A SWOT analyze was done to analyze the gap to be bridged when working towards the well established EOC from the prevailing situation.



## ii. Community based Small Scale Projects

- One of the mitigation projects under the PROMISE Sri Lanka is to conduct a training program for craftsmen and contractors on construction rules in disaster prone areas. An agreement was signed on 12th of November 2007 between National Building Research Organization and Sarvodaya Community Disaster Management centre to conduct two training programs.NBRO has initiated the work related to carry out two number training cum demonstration programmes as stipulated in the project proposal submitted to Sarvodaya by NBRO in implementation of flood Mitigatory work in Kalutara. The training programs will be held at 27<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2007 at Kalutara.
- We PROMISE- SL meet the community of Daham Mawatha of Nagoda Western GN Division to discuss the further steps of a structural mitigation project suggested to implement to build proper drainage system as a solution for the road inundation during the heavy rain. Appointed a monitoring committee for the task and related work will start in December.



# **Component 3**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> program on Governance and Disaster Risk Reduction was held from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> of November, 2007 under the same agreement which was made between SLILG and Sarvodaya Community Disaster Management Centre.

20 participants who are working in Local government institutions of Kalutara were participated to the training program.Inaddition to that 2 from SLILG, 2 from Sarvodaya and 2 from NBRO were participated to the Program .Gabrielle Igieslas, Information Networking Coordinator ,ADPC was attend to the training program as an Observer .
