Activities

Sharing of PROMISE activities for Child Fund

CDP gave Child Fund an orientation on Child Led DRR last December 1-4, 2009 in San Pablo, Laguna. It was attended by thirty nine staff and partners of Child Fund from Luzon and Mindanao. During the training, Ms. Mayfourth Luneta, PROMISE Project Coordinator, shared about the different Child Centered Activities of CDP and other partners. This included the Dagupan PROMISE experience especially the activities during the Disaster Safety Day where the children (Elementary and High School Students in Public Schools and some Private Schools in Dagupan and even tertiary level) actively participated in Risk Communication and Mitigation:

- Academic Olympics on DRR (Oratorical contest, essay writing contest, extemporaneous speech, quiz bee, tableau and others)
- Mangrove Reforestation
- Tree Planting
- Earthquake and Fire Drills

Oxfam Launch of DRR Materials

On December 14, 2009 at Sulo Hotel, Quezon City - Oxfam had a launching of different IEC Materials (DVD, books, pamphlets, CD) promoting the institutionalization of Provincial DRRM Offices in the Philippines. The experience of Albay in having the Albay Public Safety and Emergency Management Office (APSEMO) was highlighted in the said materials. Different pilot areas of Oxfam were also included in the public awareness materials. This activity was attended by NGOs, local government units, and other partners of Oxfam. CDP attended the event and invited Pasig City to be a part of this event and to learn from the other LGUs' experiences in DRR. Pasig City Disaster Coordinating Council sent representatives from the Pasig Command Control Communication Operation Center (Mr. Noel and Mr. Jeff SM) to attend the launch.

Education Cluster Workshop

On December 17, 2009, the Education Cluster of the Philippines had a Planning Workshop in UNICEF office in Makati City. They discussed on the following:

- Sharing of good practices of partners in child centered DRR (CDP presented the PROMISE child centered experience in Dagupan City from Risk assessment to different child led DRR activities).
- Review, critic and improvement of last planning workshop results
- Identification of Project Areas of partners

The activity was attended by different partner NGOs and INGOs.

BAO Meeting

Last December 8, 2009, Ms. Luneta had a meeting with Mr. Greg Evangelista, the head of the Barangay Affairs Office (He is appointed the PROMISE focal person for Pasig City), about the schedules of PROMISE for next year. They discussed on setting a schedule with the City Heads and the Barangay Captains for consultation on the upcoming PROMISE activities.

Gift giving

Trianon Fame Company for God's Glory Foundation has a yearly gift giving event. This year they decided to give some toys and food to those affected by the recent typhoons (Typhoon Ondoy and Pepeng). This aimed to help the children ease the pain, stress and trauma brought about by the disaster. They decided to coordinate with Central Luzon Conference of Seventh day Adventists (CLC) to help them choose their area. CLC asked the Adventist Community Service of Pasig to assist Trianon which in turn coordinated with CDP. CDP being a partner of Pasig City asked Mrs. Perez who is the head of all the day care centers in Pasig City to recommend a suitable place. She then recommended llogin Day Care Center in Pinagbuhatan to be the recipient of the gift giving. The event took place on December 15, 2009 in llogin Day Care Center in Pinagbuhatan, Pasig City. The children were relieved and were thankful for the event. There were 100 children who benefited in the gift giving.
