Activity Reports

Project Component -1: Development of Hydro-Meteorological Hazard based Maps and Action Plan for the Pouroshava community.

Activity-1.8: Pouroshava action plan workshop to present and validate prepared ward level detailed risk maps and action plans for selected wards:

Municipality level action plan has been developed. Intensively conduction of all wards level workshops this action plan has been developed. The action plan has been presented and shared with the service provider agencies, community participants and local elected bodies on 2nd Sept,2010 at the Jamalpur Municipality's conference room.

Activity-1.10: Printing of city level risk maps and displaying at the City Office:

All wards level risk maps have been prepared .These maps to be incorporated with Municipality levels maps and to be displayed in the EOC for using city dwellers as well as Municipality. Primarily the informative maps of ward no.1, 10 and 12 have been finalized.

Project Component -2: Mitigation and Preparedness

Activity-2.2.e: Provision of data monitoring and recording system:

Participatory monitoring and record keeping tools have been developed for community levels volunteers. ADPC conducted EOC volunteers and CBEWS volunteers training on 17th August, 10. Total 37 community volunteers, local councilors and municipality representative has been participated during day long training on 17th August, 10 at the municipality conference room.

The Technical Working Group (TWG) meeting also held on 16th August, 10 and this mechanism also shared with the TWG meeting's participants. Technical Working Group's members suggested follows for sustainability of EOC & CBEWS:

Recomandation of TWG (Technical Working Group) members for the sustainability of EOC and CBEWS $\,$

- Providing more training to the volunteers on EOC operation issue
- Developing an strong volunteers groups those are capable to work in any distress situation
- Providing honourium to the volunteers by the Municipality during Disaster period
- Providing necessary equipments to the volunteers
- Proper instruction and guidance needed for volunteers
- Strong collaboration and regular communication among EOC, volunteers and local elected bodies during disaster
- Establish strong monitoring mechanism by the Municipality on volunteers works
- Assigning A capable person on behalf of municipality to followup of regular activities during disaster. It will be helpful to give full attention of his duty
- Providing mobile phone/ need based bill to the volunteers during disaster
- Properly maintainance of EOC Materials
- Matching the information of EWS of EOC &WDB
- Quick response mechanism development for evacuation during disaster
- Using local available resources (Local Mosq's Mike,Local press media etc) for announcing EWS
- Awareness building of local community participants, students, adolescents etc.

Activity-2.2.f: Provision of display board at community level:

Community based display board for each flood gauges are going to developed. For maintaining each display board, community based record keepers (19 nos. community volunteers) have been nominated. They received training from ADPC on properly maintaining display board.

Activity-2.2.g: Training selected community members on monitoring flood gauges & EOC volunteers: For operating EOC and maintaining flood gauges community based volunteers selected. List of EOC volunteers are given bellow-

Project Component -4: Advocacy for mainstreaming Risk Management

Activity-4.1: Compiling all ward level action plans prepared under component and finalizes the Pourashava level flood mitigation action plan with PDMC and TWG: Community Based risk maps have been developed. Based on the model maps of ward no. 1, 10 and 12 rests of wards maps have been developed and all maps to be incorporated in the municipality level action plan

B. Issues Encountered and Solutions

- **CB-EWS (Community Based Early Warning System)**: It is established. All flood gauges installed and community based volunteers training has been provided. Now Municipality must be taken lead rule for continuing of CBEWS activities. ADPC rightly facilitated to the municipality authority and municipality has committed to do so.
- Provision of data monitoring and recording system: Municipality assigned EOC operator and volunteers for collecting information from each flood gauges and disseminating of information from community to EOC to community. It is a big challenge that all volunteers are not literate for keeping record of flood gauges data. Municipality should follow up of the activities related to data monitoring and recording system.
