

DISASTER MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE IN VIETNAM



Disaster Management Centre was invited to be National Training Partner of Promise Vietnam and they submitted letter of commitment.

DISASTER MANAGEMENT CENTER (DMC)

- Functioning under the administrative control of DDMFC MARD (Department of Dike Management, Flood and Storm Control - Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development).
- Being the Government executive body for communication of disaster warnings, advises and provides consultation of flood and storm management, prevention and control, disaster mitigation for the whole of Viet Nam in order to ensure safety of production activities and socio-economic development of the country.





DISASTER MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE IN VIETNAM

RESPONSIBILITIES OF DMC

- Coordinating with National Hydro-meteorology Center, monitor hydrometeorological developments and provide timely consultation to DDMFC in order to take suitable response action for disaster mitigation;
- Supporting CCFSC (Central Committee for Flood and Storm Control) in flood mitigation by participating in decision making for projects;
- Participating in formulating strategy for flood and storm control and disaster mitigation for each region and for the whole country;







.RESPONSIBILITIES OF DMC

- Setting up advanced communication network in coordination with local authorities and sector to collect information and issue timely warning for disaster management;
- Compiling data of damages due to disaster analyze them and plan rehabilitation measures;
- Providing consultancy service on flood and storm disaster mitigation;
- Providing consultancy service for training, workshop and technical solutions.









- Organizing national and international disaster related workshops and meetings;
- Designing and implementing training programs in the capital as well as in the provinces in cooperation with other agencies;
- Coordination with ADPC in organizing workshop on "Disaster Risk Communication" for the pilot project in T.T.Hue Province and preparation of a 5 year action plan;
- Coordination with IFRC and VNRC in preparing training materials on public disaster awareness;
- Support to develop National and action plan on natural disaster management.







TRAINING EVENTS PLANNEDIDMC

The Disaster Management Center (DMC) will be invited to participate at least two training / workshops under Advocacy for Mainstreaming risk Management in urban governance.

COMPONENT 4 - ADVOCACY FOR MAINSTREAMING RISK MANAGEMENT IN **URBAN GOVERNANCE**

Activity 4.1: WS on CBDRM institutionalization (Training/workshop) A workshop on institutionalization of CBDRM would be conducted with reference to ADPC materials for policy makers at different levels.

Activity 4.7: Workshop on impact of climate change and urban risk management at the community level and priority actions at national level to support community based adaptation strategy A workshop on impact of climate change and urban risk management would be conducted at the community level. The workshop reports and recommendations regarding priority actions would be sent to national level.

INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF REGIONAL TRAINING AT NATIONAL LEVEL

- The training course contributes to enhance capacity of DMC staffs;
- Knowledge of regional course on governance and risk management will be applied into:
 - DMC's work;
 - Training programmes of DMC at national level.









OPPORTUNITIES

- DMC's willingness to participate into Regional events and strong support to institutionalization of Regional training at national level;
- Opportunity to learn DMC's application of Regional training at national level in 2 years implementation of Promise project;
- Training partner is at national level, so they have chances to institutionalize the training course.









DIFFICULTIES

- No budget for piloting some training courses applying knowledge got from the Regional Training course;
- It took time to define the training partner meeting the requirements.
