•July 16 of every year is declared as City Disaster Preparedness to create Public Awareness for DRM









- 4. Form an alliance with these towns and cities to have concerted effort on disaster preparedness and flood mitigation.








Vertical Mainstreaming National Mainstreaming Advocacy
