A Delegation from Department of Disaster Relief of Ministry of Civil Affairs (MCA)/National Disaster Reduction Center of China (NDRCC) and Beijing Civil Affairs Bureau, People's Republic of China Visited Thailand from 22-27 May 2011

Mr. XIAO Xin, Deputy Division Director of Department of Disaster Relief of Ministry of Civil Affairs, People’s Republic of China led a delegation of eight officials to Thailand for a study tour on disaster risk management from 22-27 May 2011. The study visit was one of the activities based on an agreement signed between MCA and ADPC in August 2010.
