The capacity of CCDMs and VDCs is enhanced to analyse their vulnerability and actively prepare their communities for the risks of floods and drought.</li> <li>2. Increased availability of DP knowledge and skills across community members in target villages.</li> <li>3. Reduced vulnerability to disaster through small-scale disaster preparedness and mitigation initiatives carried out at the village community level.</li> </ol>
