Results	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Improved networking mechanism for mainstreaming CBDRM into government disaster management policy. 2. Increased capacity of Provincial Red Cross (PRC), District and Provincial Committees for Disaster Management and Commune Council (CC) in Community Based Disaster Risk Management (CBDRM) 3. Increases capacity of communities in institutional strengthening and mobilising people to assess disaster risks and to develop Village Disaster Risk Reduction Plan (VDRP). 4. Rehabilitated and improved small-scale infrastructure to reduce disaster risks and mitigate disaster impacts
Key activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.1. Host and actively participate in the CDRR forum; invite Vietnamese delegation to participate in the CDRR forum hosted by LWF 1.2. Host AZEECON exchange visit for 2 participants each from LWF India, Nepal and RDRS Bangladesh and 15 LWF Cambodia staff 2.1. Facilitate and coordinate National Committee of Disaster Management (NCDM) to conduct 4 ToT courses (5-day) on CBDRM to PRC and P/DCDM staff in 3 provinces 2.2. Facilitate NCDM to conduct 4 training courses (5-day) in CBDRM to D/PCDM and CC staff in 3 provinces 3.1. Select 100 VDV's from 100 villages. 3.2. Facilitate and coordinate with NCDM and CRC to provide 10 training courses to 100 VDV's on CBDRM (5-day) by NCDM, CBDRP (4-day), HVCA and VDRP (5-day) by CRC. 3.3. Facilitate and coordinate with CRC and NCDM to provide 14 First Aid training courses (6-day by CRC, 5-day by NCDM) to 100 VDV's, 100 VDC's and 100 VHV's 3.4. Facilitate and coordinate with CRC and NCDM to provide 6 training courses (3-day) on CBDPM to 100 VDC's. 3.5. LWF field staff (from ToT) to provide 1-day following up training to 100 VDV's. 3.6. Provide 3-day refresher training to 100 VDV's and 100 VDC's of previous 100 selected villages. It will be done by LWF field staff in cooperation with PRC or P/DCDM. 3.7. Facilitate trained VDV's and VDC's to provide training on CBDPM to all VDC members, village leaders and other interested community members. 3.8. Purchase and disseminate IEC Disaster Awareness materials 3.9. VDC's and VDV's with support of LWF field staff and CC staff conduct disaster awareness to communities members in their respective villages 3.10. Facilitate exchange visits for 100 new villages (3 people per each village) to learn experiences from previous DIPECHO villages 4. Facilitate and support VCDM and VDC's to implement micro project as resulted from VDRP such as treadle pumps, family and community ponds, open wells, small canals, small dikes etc.
