CBRR SATGANA/KSR teams and ToTs train CBAT in DM according to CBRR curriculum 3. Conduct regular meetings with SATGANA/KSR groups & communities 4. Provision of uniforms and CBRR/CBDP Kit 5. CBAT mobilize the communities in disaster prone areas 6. Conduct socialization of CBRR Programme to 16 communities 7. SATGANA/KSR teams and CBATS conduct PRA and risk mapping to identify local needs and priorities 8. Conduct KAP and household baseline survey to obtain baseline data for monitoring. 9. Facilitate community to formulate five-year Risk Reduction Plans according to outcome of PRA and baseline survey 10. CBAT organise regular community meetings 11.
