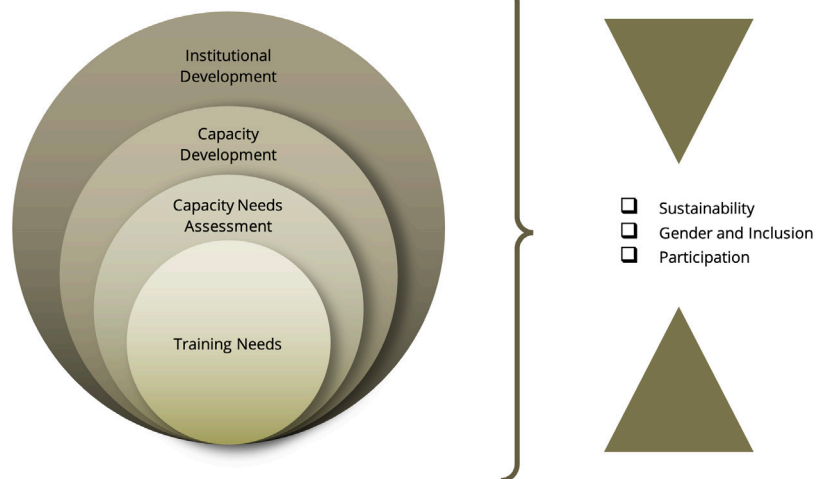

Key Focus Areas:

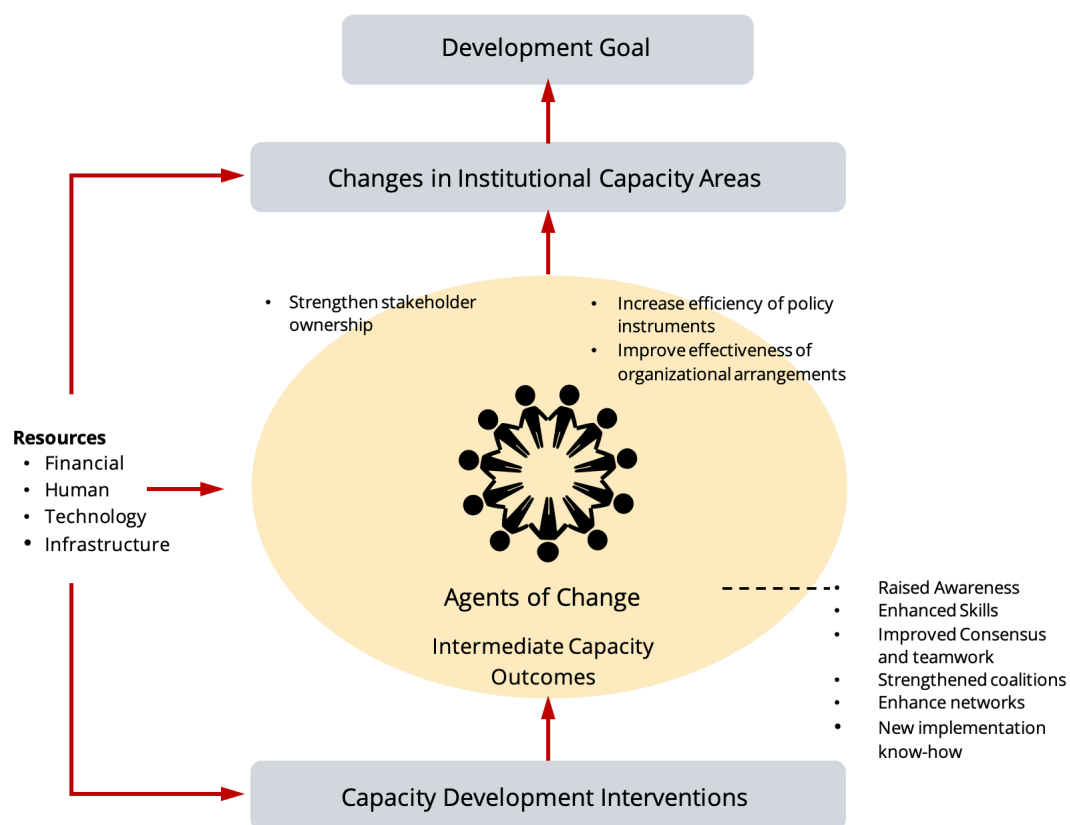
- Leadership development for disaster risk management (DRM) practitioners.
